**CONSERVATION - THE PROTECTION OF PLANTS, ANIMALS, NATURAL AREAS AND INTERESTING AND IMPORTANT PLACES**

**FORAGING - SEARCHING FOR FOOD AND VEGETATION TO EAT**

**GREATER ONE-HORNED RHINO - FOUND IN INDIA AND NEPAL, THIS RHINO SPECIES HAS THICK SKIN FOLDS, WHICH SOMETIMES LOOKS LIKE ARMOUR**

**DUNG - RHINO POO**

**HABITAT - THE NATURAL HOME OR ENVIRONMENT OF AN ANIMAL, PLANT, OR OTHER ORGANISM**



# **RHINO RANGERS**

**HERBIVORES** - AN ANIMAL WHICH EATS PLANTS (RHINOS ARE HERBIVORES – THEY DO LOVE THEIR GREENS!!)

**HERD** - A LARGE GROUP OF ANIMALS THAT LIVE TOGETHER (OFTEN HOOFED MAMMALS)

**HOOF** - THE HORNY PART OF A RHINO'S FOOT

**JAVAN RHINO** - ONE OF THE RAREST MAMMALS ON EARTH, ONLY CURRENTLY FOUND IN ONE NATIONAL PARK IN INDONESIA

**MIDDEN** - A MOUND MADE OF ANIMAL POO, WHICH RHINOS OFTEN USE TO COMMUNICATE WITH EACH OTHER



# **RHINO RANGERS**

**SCIENTIFIC NAME - THE NAME GIVEN BY SCIENTISTS TO EACH UNIQUE TYPE OF ANIMAL (SPECIES). THEY ARE MADE UP OF TWO LATIN WORDS (THE FIRST WORD IS THE NAME OF THE BIGGER FAMILY TO WHICH THE ANIMAL BELONGS AND THE SECOND WORD IS THE UNIQUE SPECIES NAME**

**SUMATRAN RHINO - THE SMALLEST OF THE TWO RHINO SPECIES FROM INDONESIA**

**TERRITORY - AN AREA USED AND OFTEN 'MARKED' BY A RHINO AS THEIR HOME. SOMETIMES THIS IS UP TO 50KM<sup>2</sup>**



# **RHINO RANGERS**

**WALLOW** - TO LIE OR ROLL AROUND SLOWLY IN DEEP, WET EARTH, SAND, OR WATER. RHINOS LOVE A WALLOW IN THE MUD TO SOOTHE THEIR SKIN AND HELP THEM TO COOL OFF!

**WHITE RHINO** - A RHINO SPECIES FOUND IN AFRICA – THE LARGEST OF ALL RHINO SPECIES
