HOW YOU'RE SAVING RHINOS

Since 1994, our incredible supporters have helped to send more than **£30 million** towards critical rhino conservation programmes in Africa and Asia, making a significant impact on rhinos and the communities around them. Here are some examples of how your fundraising could make a difference:

£3 may provide a life-saving first aid kit for tireless rhino rangers

£8 might buy a food ration pack for one ranger

£10 could purchase a comfortable foam mattress for a ranger on patrol, supporting their time in the field

£15 can provide a teacher with a Conservation Guide, inspiring the next generation of conservationists

£50 could purchase a good quality waterproof jacket, keeping rangers warm and dry

£100 could buy an 80L backpack for rangers in Indonesia, helping them to safely carry all the kit they need for weeks on patrol

£122 can buy a field ranger's uniform, ensuring they are well-equipped, comfortable, and in suitable clothing for vital activities

£300 could pay for a community project farming initiative, empowering local people to develop their natural resources sustainably

£1,000 could provide vital medical treatment for rhinos, including snare removal or caring for an orphaned rhino calf

Your fundraising will play a vital role in continuing this legacy. Together, we can secure a brighter future for rhinos.

KICK-START YOUR FUNDRAISING

Not sure where to begin your fundraising journey? Here's how to get started with our top tips for success!

Set a fundraising goal

Your target will keep you motivated and focused. Think about how much you want to raise. Don't be afraid to set an ambitious goal!

Choose your fundraising idea

Pick an event or activity that excites you! Whether it's running a marathon, hosting a bake sale or holding a quiz night, make sure it's something you're passionate about. Get creative with your ideas. The more fun and exciting your event is, the more people will want to get involved.

Create your fundraising page

Create a personalised fundraising page to make donating easy for friends and family. Share your story, explain why rhinos need help, and show how donations will make a difference. Add fun photos or videos to stand out

Top Tip: If you're doing a Save the Rhino challenge, check if a page was set up for you before creating a new one!

Fundraising little and often

Fundraising "little and often" is a great approach, especially in the current economic climate. It helps donors budget their support and reduces pressure on you, as you're less likely to feel the need to hit your target in just one or two attempts.

Starting your fundraising as early as possible lets you accumulate funds over time, making the process more manageable. As they say, "fundraising is a marathon, not a sprint"!



Keep the momentum going

As your event approaches, continue to connect with your supporters. Share your progress, celebrate milestones and remind them why you are raising money. When people see how passionate you are, they'll be more inclined to support you.

Say thank you

Take a moment to thank everyone who supported you on your fundraising journey. Share how much was raised and let them know the difference their support will make.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

Need a little inspiration? Here are some of our favourite methods for raising vital funds for rhinos

Bake sale

Everyone loves a bake sale! It's a fun and easy way to raise funds while showing off your baking skills. Offer a variety of sweet and savoury treats, or pick a theme like Christmas or Halloween. Remember to label allergens clearly.

Host a rhino-themed quiz night for a wildly good time! Gather your friends, charge an entry fee, and offer rhino-inspired prizes. You can boost your fundraising with a raffle or a "best rhino costume" contest. Whether in a local pub or online, it's a fun way to support rhino conservation.

Non-uniform day

Add some fun with a non-uniform day! Encourage participants to wear something wacky, wild, or rhino-themed. Charge a small fee to take part and raise funds for rhino conservation. Bonus points for those who rock a rhino costume — we've got one you can borrow!

Charity fun run

Get active and raise funds with a charity fun run! Whether you walk, jog, or sprint, it's a great way to involve people of all fitness levels. Add excitement with a theme like a fancy-dress or colour run, and borrow our iconic Save the Rhino costume to stand out. Encourage sponsorships and celebrate participants with medals or certificates!

Car boot sale

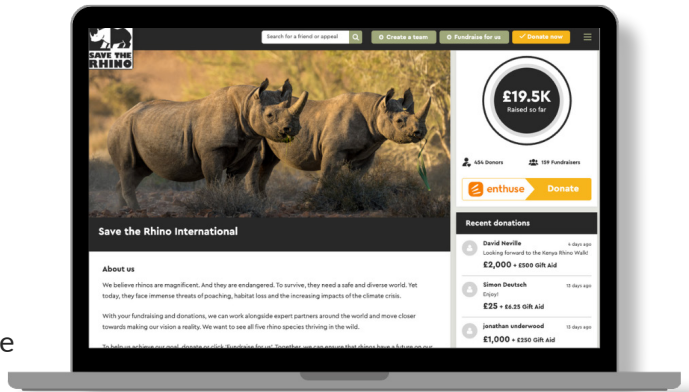

CREATE YOUR FUNDRAISING PAGE

| Creating your page is quick and easy!

Save the Rhino International's preferred fundraising platform is Enthuse. If you've signed up for a challenge event through Save the Rhino, make sure to check whether a fundraising page has automatically been set up for you upon registration, before you create a new one.



Follow these simple steps to get going:

Fill in your details to start creating your fundraising page

Personalise your page and make it stand out from the crowd

Follow the steps to personalise your page. You'll be guided through the following customisation steps:

- Set a fundraising target – don't be afraid to aim high!
- Upload a profile photo so that your supporters know it's your page
- Choose a header image that will set the tone for your fundraising page
- Tell your story and share why you are fundraising for Save the Rhino International! Why not include examples of how your fundraising will make a lasting impact for rhinos?
- Customise your page link so that it is easy to remember and simple for donors to reach your page
- Decide your marketing preferences and select if you'd like to hear more from us

HOW TO PAY IN YOUR FUNDRAISING?

The great news is that all money you raise through Enthuse comes directly to us. However, if you are collecting cash donations, we have different options for you to get the donations safely to us.

1. Bank transfer

When on our [website](#), select 'Fundraising' as the source of your donation and add any comments that you'd like us to know. If you have an Enthuse fundraising page, then you can add this as 'offline fundraising'.

Please remember:

1. All fundraising donations should reach the charity within 28 days of collection
2. Please do not deduct expenses from the funds raised unless you have had prior approval from Save the Rhino, and you have cleared this with your donors

FUNDRAISING GUIDELINES

Advice on keeping things legal and safe while fundraising

Collecting funds in public

Please note that you will require a licence from your local authority if you intend to collect funds for your campaign door-to-door or in a public space such as sports centres, shopping malls or train stations. There are also specialist guidelines surrounding bucket collections. Please check with your local authority in plenty of time (at least a few weeks) before your intended collection date.

Raffles and lotteries

There are strict laws and regulations surrounding “gambling”, which includes raffles and lotteries. For more information, please visit the Gambling Commission’s website: www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk/licensees-and-businesses/licences-and-fees and email fundraising@savetherhino.org before you intend to hold such an event.

Tax-effective giving in the USA

If you are in the USA and looking for tax-effective giving, one-off donations may be made via Save the Rhino International, Inc. (SRI Inc), which is a 501(C)(3) not-for profit organisation. Large donations (defined as >\$1,000 USD) must be made via a bank transfer.

For bank details, contact finance@savetherhino.org to arrange this. Smaller donations can be made directly at www.savetherhinoinc.com ensuring that you make it clear that your donation is to support your fundraising efforts!

Please remember that you are fundraising “In aid of”, rather than “on behalf of Save the Rhino”.

Gift Aid

Gift Aid is a scheme that allows and enables UK-based charities to claim back tax on all donations made by UK taxpayers. It is critical to Save the Rhino and other charities because it increases the impact of your donations, with no additional cost or expense to you. For every £1 donated that’s eligible for Gift Aid, Save the Rhino can claim back an additional 25p.

Gift Aid is automatically organised with your sponsor when they donate via Enthuse. When you are collecting donations offline, to make Gift Aid available, please ask donors to provide their first and last names, addresses, and their express permission to provide Gift Aid: this is achieved by simply ticking the correct box next to their name on the sponsorship form.

It is important to note that the details are solely for HMRC and are never used for Save the Rhino’s marketing purposes. If you require a printable Gift Aid form, please get in touch with us on fundraising@savetherhino.org.

General health and safety

- You are responsible for ensuring your fundraising activities are conducted safely and efficiently. Save the Rhino International cannot accept liability for the fundraiser(s) or anybody participating in a fundraising event held in aid of the charity
- Conduct a risk assessment before any event involving sports, parties, dancing, etc. More information may be accessed at www.hse.org.uk
- Brief all participants on fitness requirements, potential hazards, special equipment, and the type of behaviour and standards acceptable at the event
- Check with your local authority for any required licences (e.g., for car boot sales, alcohol sales, or public entertainment) as fees may apply. Always check whether special licences are required, e.g., a licence to sell alcohol, soaps, cosmetics or to undertake public entertainment
- Ensure events are properly supervised
- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult with parental permission and necessary background checks (e.g., DBS). Do not leave valuables, keys, money, or access to premises unattended
- Check if insurance is required for your venues or events

CHECKLIST

Let's make sure you've checked the following before you charge off on your fundraising adventure:

- ✓ Have you chosen the type of event for your fundraising?
- ✓ Selected a time, date and place for your event?
- ✓ Been granted permission by the relevant parties?
- ✓ Notified Save the Rhino International of your fundraising?
- ✓ Asked everybody to sponsor you? E.g., friends, family, colleagues, local groups, etc.?
- ✓ Set up an Enthuse fundraising page online?
- ✓ Collected all donations?
- ✓ Thanked all of your amazing sponsors and supporters?
- ✓ Paid in money to Save the Rhino International?
